


U.S. Quarterly GDP









El Paso County New Jobs








Colorado Springs MSA GMP by Sector









El Paso County & U.S. Age Groups





Population Growth 2020-2050










Hotel Occupancy Rate





Monthly Sales & Use Tax Collection






COS Enplanements


Educational Attainment
